## Sisters of Lartelare

## Kaurna Women's Art Collective

31 August – 19 October

Sisters of Lartelare is an art show by the Kaurna Women's Art Collective that explores Kaurna history, stories, and culture related to Yartapuulti which is the Kaurna word for Port Adelaide.

The project is led by Bonny Brodie, a future Kaurna leader, with help from Aunty Margaret Brodie who is an Elder in the community. It focuses on learning about Kaurna culture from different First Nations female leaders, how to share their stories while learning how to make scents from native plants and dying fabrics.

This exhibition builds on previous workshops, community events, and public displays, and is being shown at ACE for the first time. Sisters of Lartelare emphasises respect and care, aiming to create artwork that challenges colonial views and helps preserve and share Kaurna cultural practices for future generations.
